

# BLUEBERRY MUFFIN EXCAVATION



To understand how careful archaeologists must be when they're excavating, have a go at excavating a blueberry muffin. Imagine the muffin is your archaeological site and the blueberries are your finds.

Document your process and discoveries - we would love to see them!

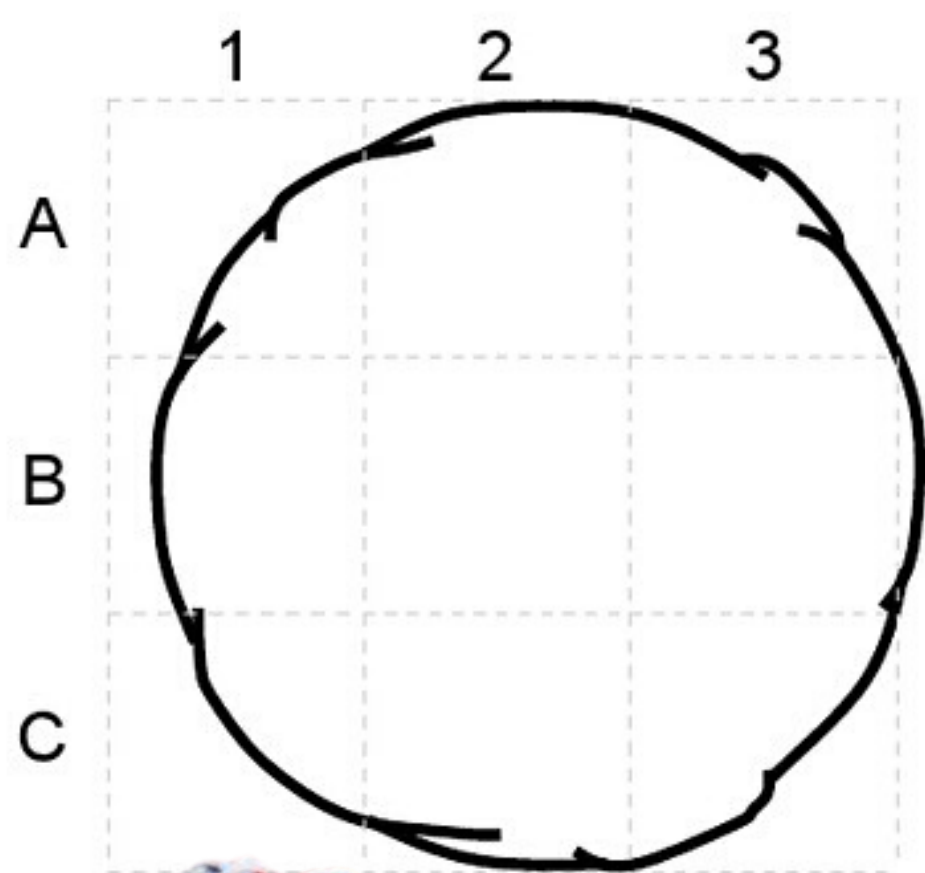
You will need:

- A cocktail stick
- One blueberry muffin

Directions:

- Draw the top of the muffin before you begin - think about what you might discover
- Use your cocktail stick to excavate the blueberries from the muffin. Try not to pick up the cake while you're working
- When you find a blueberry, carefully move it to the edge of your plate without damaging it. Don't touch it with your fingers, only the cocktail stick
- Practice mapping the muffin and blueberries just like an archaeologist would do with an archaeological site.
